

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

City Primary School has a proud tradition with school uniforms. The dress requirements of City Beach Primary School have been developed by the School Board in consultation with students, parents and staff.

DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY BEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Students should ensure that they take appropriate action to protect themselves from the sun when outdoors. The NO HAT, NO PLAY school policy applies in summer, autumn and spring. Hats are optional in the winter months of June, July and August, although they are encouraged to worn at all times. White broad brimmed hats are available from the uniform exchange. Students who do not wear a hat during in summer, autumn and spring will be restricted to the gazebo during recess and lunch breaks. During sport they will be placed in a supervised, shaded area.
- No thongs, health or beach sandals are permitted. Appropriate sports shoes, school shoes or school sandals are to be worn. Brightly coloured skate shoes are not permitted as they are not appropriate for sports.
- Jewellery: Neck chains are discouraged. For safety reasons, children may wear the following items of jewellery only: Earrings (studs or sleepers) and a watch

- Students with long hair (shoulder length) are to have it tied back.

Kindergarten

Students attending Kindergarten are not required to wear the school uniform due to the nature of activities they undertake in their day. They are encouraged to wear comfortable “play” clothes which are easy for them to manage to develop independent toileting skills. They are required to wear appropriate footwear to Kindergarten each day but remove their shoes in the classroom to aid in the development of growing feet.

UNIFORM SHOP

Uniforms are supplied by Jenny Franklin Distributors. Uniforms can be purchased directly from their warehouse which is located at Unit 1, 85 Guthrie Street in Osborne Park. Trading hours are 7:30am to 3:30pm Monday to Thursday and 7:30am to 12:00pm Friday. *Girls grey shorts are not available through the supplier and will need to be purchased from a different source.

Uniform order forms can also be found on the school webpage under the Parents and Community tab. Simply download and complete an order form and drop it into the office. Once your order has been processed it will be delivered to the office for your collection.

Uniform Exchange – second-hand school clothes

The school P&C operates a small second-hand clothing exchange in the Music Room. The uniform exchange is open on first Wednesday of each month from 3:15pm to 3:45pm and Friday mornings when there is an assembly from 8:15am to 8:45am. New school hats, school bags and bathers (limited sizes) are also available for purchase here.
