Weather-resistant upcycled sculptures

What You Need to Know

- All entries must have an upcycled component of at least 80%.
- All entries must be **weather-resistant** (be prepared for rainy or windy conditions).
- Designated areas are allocated for each category and installation is from **7:30am-10:30pm**.
- All entries must be **child-friendly** and securely installed.
- The school grounds must not be damaged by installing and/or removing sculpture.
- Entrants (and/or parents) are responsible for installing and removing sculpture i.e. attaching entry form to the back of the sculpture and bringing all necessary equipment.
- The sculpture is the responsibility of the entrant and must be removed after the exhibition.
- Entry Form – all entrants are required to complete an entry form.
 - Place entry form in a plastic sleeve.
 - Neat printing is expected, otherwise please type.
 - Year 2 to 6 students are required to submit a short artist statement.
 - Ensure the statement is grammatically correct and double check spelling.
 - Retain entry form for Visual Diary.
- **WILF:** The sculptures will be judged on five criteria.
 - Artist Statement (Yrs 2-6)* – shows clear links between the sculpture and the theme.
 - Creativity and Originality – how you interpret the theme.
 - Innovative use of materials – how you upcycle the materials.
 - Quality of Craftsmanship and Construction – see Newsletter N^o 2 for some suggestions.
 - Visual Impact – this is the WOW factor.
- **Technical skills, creative reuse and links to theme *Backyard Adventures*.**
- Group winners must share the prize.


