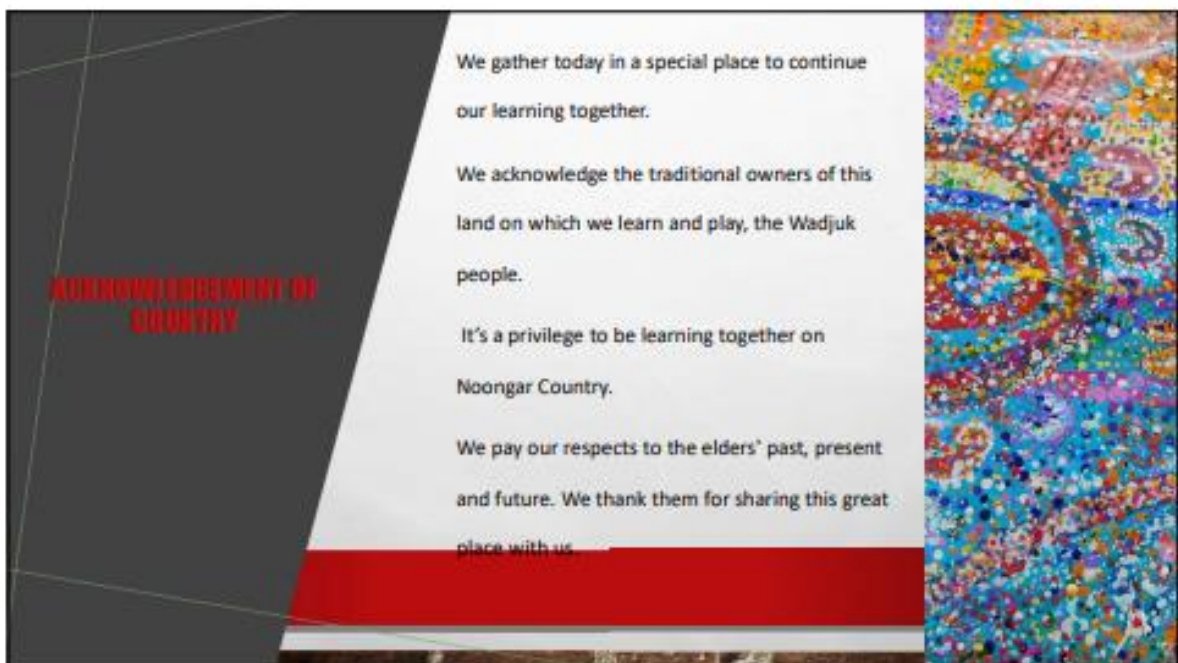

- Industrial agreements (class sizes)
- Nature of student enrolments (characteristics)
- Budget

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Placement of Students
